



Wolverines Meeting 11/5/2007

The November meeting was held at the Mt. Clemens Public Library, and President Jerry LeLacheur called the meeting to order a little after 7 PM. There were 8 members present, including the 4 officers.

#### Old Business:

Glenn Meller, Treasurer, gave the financial report, and covered items from the last meeting at the library.

Our balance is still "in the black", after all items were paid for this year.

There will be just a few minor expenses due at the end of 2007.

Glenn presented a pie chart, showing the source of our revenue, and another showing our expenditures. Some of the facts:

Twenty-seven percent of our revenue comes from the 50/50 activity.

The expense of the road will not exist next year, and it appeared as a sizeable slice of the expenses.

Half of the miscellaneous expenses were spent on stump removal.

Our membership amounted to 26 members, with one as a junior member.

Jerry LeLacheur read the meeting minutes he took during the last meeting, as Secretary Dave Bacon was absent.

This included an announcement that new officers will be elected at this meeting, and a discussion about the road with the thought we should add more crushed asphalt to it.

Also we discussed the possibility of a new porta-potty supplier. We all agreed that we were very happy with our present supplier, and his service has been very good, so the subject was dropped.

#### New Business:

We discussed an optical illusion that presents a difficulty that we must make well known to all. This affects the pilot on final at the West end of the field. When you turn final, and think you are aligned with the field, you may find out you are behind a row of trees, and it is too late to recover. Many pilots agree with this, and feel we should make sure we don't forget this.

Jerry informed us that the Skymasters are having a symposium on the new spread-spectrum technology for R/C use. This will be held at the Larson Middle School on Long Lake (18 Mile Road) on January 9, at 7 PM.
