


Meeting of the Fly'n' Wolverines

June 7, 2008, at the Field

V.P. Bob Branch had the meeting called to order just after 11 AM, there were 10 members present, and two guests, Jack DeLisle, and Jim Laubenthal.



Treasurer's report:

Glen gave the Treasurer's report and included a \$50 expenditure for equipment bought from Ken Bist, a past member that decided to clean out his RC equipment. This will be auctioned off at our fun fly. Thanks to Pete and Glen who put in the extra fortitude to obtain this for our club.

Our Field-Road Conditions:

The natural tree canopy over the road keeps the road moist, so a couple of trees were identified to remove to help with this problem. We are warned to be careful of the trees with thorns, as the tractor required a \$200 tire repair because of this.

It was mentioned that we should get three loads of "agate" to fix our road.

Our landlord advised that we wait a month before adding rocks to the road, because of the present moist road conditions.

Our Field-Entrance:

We need to put a cable across the road, so that people know it is not able to be used. The problem is that it is softer the further you go, and a person just gets trapped at the end. It was proposed that we put in two posts a cable and a combination lock, which Glen volunteered to get.

The posts may not hold up but we can replace them with something sturdier, depending on what happens to them.

Our Field-Model Tables:

Glen will have the tables #5 and #6 ready before the fun fly, and he and Dave will get them in place.

Our Field-Careful on Final:

Bob Branch pointed out that there is a bit of an optical illusion at the West end of our field, it is very easy to get behind some trees that you think you have already passed as you make your approach, so keep the plane up where you can see it.

On the East, we must not fly past the two tall trees, one is affectionately called "Pete's Tree", and the other is directly across from it. Any further is "Out of bounds", and will disturb others, so don't go that far.

Events-Fun Fly:

Bill Wesler, the Fun-Fly Coordinator, reports that Jack DeLisle will be our event announcer for our Fun Fly, as he has done a wonderful job for us in the past.

The Eagles will hold a combat demonstration also, which should be quite an attraction.

Joe will cook, as he also has done such a great job in the past.

There will be three events, and in each the lowest time and the lowest points will be the winner.

There will be a "silent auction" where people put a written bid in a cup next to the item they want, and after all have bid, the cup is emptied and the highest bid wins.

Jack provided announcements for our web site, and the webmaster (Dave) thanks him for the great job he has done with this.

We need to find lime for our field line marker; Pete reported that this came from Matt last time.
