The meeting was held at the Algoniac School Cafeteria.
There were 13 members present.

Secretary's Report:

The Secretary read the minutes from our last meeting, which are posted on our site.

Treasurer's Report:

It appears that mid-air collisions are pretty frequent, so this must be expected. Your secretary caused a mid-air with Bob Branch's "Monster" biplane, and he did it with Glen Meller's plane. He was able to accomplish this in just 10 feet of flight, so be ready for it!
