



Wolverines meeting 10/8/2011

The meeting was held at the Wolverine's field
There were 16 members present.

President Jerry LeLacheur called the meeting to order.

Secretary's Report:

The Secretary read the minutes from our last meeting, which are posted on our site.

Treasurer's Report:

Glen reported that we have \$570 after all expenses were paid for this year.

General Discussion:

New Business:

Maintenance on our road:

A vote was taken on using some of our funds to get two more truckloads of gravel for our road. This would leave us \$355 for next year. It was approved by unanimous vote.

Keith will supply the tractor and trailer, and Bill Welser will use his truck.

Mowing:

Jerry said that we need volunteers for mowing, and they should come out Saturday or Sunday in the morning. Please contact Jerry for lessons on using the tractor and mower. Gordy verified that he needs some help.

Some sites have sign-up rosters, but Jerry has observed that this doesn't work. Another suggestion was to reduce the dues of those doing the mowing, but there seemed to be no perfect answer. This is everyone's responsibility, we have 27 members, and we need some help! Just to point out the value of this, one club pays \$2000 a year for mowing! Gordy suggested we have a rotation routine, that the Eagles do this with the duty assigned to 2 at a time.

We can discuss this further at the next meeting at the library.

Utility Tables:

It was mentioned that we need more tables for holding planes, and Jerry will get lumber for these tables. The cost is \$130 for 2 tables. Dale said he had some Wolmanized wood that would do for this, and he will put it on our field, so they can be built on-site. A vote was taken to allow purchasing of additional materials to finish these tables, and it passed unanimously.

Tractor Maintenance:

The tractor needs a tune-up, Jerry will talk with the owner about this, and we should pay for it, or at least pay half, as we are the only users. This was voted on, and passed. Dave Waldecker got "volunteered" to do this, and Keith will help. Gerry Hanna can get a discount at "JD" where he works.

NOTE This was done by the owner the next day, when Dave Bacon was out at the field. Took him just a few minutes, and he was glad to do it.
