



Wolverines meeting 7/7/2012

The meeting was held at the Fly'n wolverines Club Field.

Treasurer's Report:

The Fun Fly:

Discussions on the Fun-Fly continued with the date of Aug 18th picked.

We need a preparation day, and volunteers can come assist Gordy.

There will be four events, Bomb drop, Dice roll, Team taxi, and Clim & glide.

Each pilot must use a "primary plane", no specials for each event, but he can have a backup plane. Lowest score is the winner.

We need a monitor for the limit on the power-on time for the Climb & glide, as electricians are so quiet.

We must instruct the pilot to not watch the bomb in the Bomb drop event, as his plane will crash!

Gary offered to buy extra food, or maybe obtain it from the Eagles, as their event will be 1 week earlier than ours. Bill W. will coordinate this.

Dave W. will bring an air horn.

Need two boxes outlined in the grass for the events. Dave W. will review all the equipment needed for the events.

We expect 15-20 pilots, and many more as spectators. Paul volunteered to help with anything needed.

New Business:

Tractor:

The tractor is broken. The axle hub was welded to a different shaft, and that is what failed. The owner is having it rebuilt with a new axle, and brakes. This is being done by his mechanic from Armada. We should split the cost, and we may require a special assessment. A motion was made by D. Bacon to have a \$15 assessment, was seconded by Glen Meller, and this was unanimously accepted by the members.
