



## **Wolverines meeting 7/13/2013**

This meeting was called by Jerry, to discuss our new mowers, and was held at the field. There were 14 members present.

**The meeting was called to order at 11:00 by V.P. Bill Welser.**

### **Treasurer's Report:**

Glen reported that we have three new members, we would like to welcome Brian and Frank Borawski, and Mike Caiger. The cash on hand is presently \$1550.46 which allows us to spend a little on 2 loads of stone for our road. The Treasurer's report was accepted by the membership.

### **Old Business:**

#### **Grass Cutting:**

Bill W said that we have 2 mowers now, and they are easy to run, as they are common riding mowers with a PTO. The mower deck is activated with the PTO switch, which should be engaged at a higher throttle setting. The mowing is conducted at full throttle, on both mowers. Bill pointed out that it takes six man-hours to complete everything.

Bill also asked to please not call him to see if the grass is mowed, as he has to go 10 miles to see if it is. If we setup teams of 2 or 3 guys to mow once or twice a week, then it should always be mowed, and calling anyone will be unnecessary.

Also, Bill said, stay off the drive with the mowers, as the rocks will damage the blades.

Glenn then said that he worked out a plan and announced the seven teams of 3 each, who will be responsible for one week, and produced a chart that shows the mowing responsibility will come up twice during flying season. The membership accepted this plan, and Dave Bacon will send it to all members. Dave will post it on our web site.

### **Cutting Paths in the Brush:**

During team # 5's mowing schedule, the owner, Chuck, came out and cut paths in the woods for us. He made three or four U shaped paths and an adjoining path connecting them. Chuck did say that some of the vines across the paths were very difficult to deal with, and restricted some of his progress. We thanked him profusely, and he was happy to help us.

### **Mower Repair:**

The large mower still sits in the weeds, West of the parking area, and since the new mowers work so well, there is little interest in repairing this.

Keith wanted to come out with a sicle bar to trim the edges of the road, so we can get the 2 loads of stone "box-spread" on the road. Presently Keith is off with a bad foot, so this will wait.
