They warn us that a crashed battery may go off later, by itself, because of damage. And they go off due to overcharge. If the cells are poorly balanced, like an old fashoned charger would do, there is a chance of igniting them before they reach full charge. Keith reminds us to always use a LiPo bag for the batteries, especially when charging.
